Service Theme THE HOLY MINISTRY PREACHES CHRIST DESPITE PERSECUTION

From its birth, the New Testament Church has been persecuted. The religious leaders in Jerusalem tried to stamp it out, but they only succeeded in spreading Christianity throughout Judea and Samaria. The Roman Empire persecuted Christians with stakes and lions, yet God's Church exploded with growth in those early centuries. In Martin Luther's day, both the pope and emperor sought to stop the gospel movement that was spreading from Germany. But God was a mighty fortress for the Church. Still today the Church is persecuted. Every day 13 Christians worldwide are killed because of their faith. Another 12 are arrested or imprisoned simply because they profess faith in Christ Jesus. We have freedom of religion in North America, but that is no guarantee for a life free of persecution. Until judgment day, some will attempt to shout down the truth of Christ. We will be persecuted. That won't stop us. The holy ministry preaches Christ despite persecution. Christ never promised his Church that ministry would operate unopposed. But he did promise to give courage to his witnesses.


First Lesson

Jeremiah 20 :7-13 (EHV)

For prophesying God's truth Jeremiah had been beaten and put in stocks. Yet Jeremiah refused to remain silent.

⁷You persuaded me, Lord, and I agreed to it. You are stronger than I am, and you won out. I have become a laughingstock all day long. and everyone is mocking me. ⁸Whenever I speak, I cry out. I cry out, "Violence and destruction!" But the word of the Lord has brought scorn on me. I am mocked all day long. ⁹If I say, "I will not mention him or speak in his name anymore," then there is a burning fire in my heart, shut up in my bones, and I am weary of holding it in. I cannot! ¹⁰I hear many whispering, "Terror on every side!" All my close friends, those who are watching for my fall, say. "Denounce him! Let's denounce him.

Perhaps he can be pressured into making a mistake. Then we will have the upper hand against him, and we will take our revenge on him." ¹¹But the Lord is with me like a terrifying warrior. So my persecutors will stumble, and they will not gain the upper hand. They will be put to shame completely, because they have not been successful. Their eternal disgrace will never be forgotten. ¹²Lord of Armies, you test the righteous. You see the heart and the mind. Let me see your vengeance on them, for I have laid out my case before you. ¹³Sing to the Lord! Praise the Lord, for he has delivered the life of the needv from the hand of the wicked.


Second Lesson

2 Timothy 4:1-8 (EHV)

Paul taught that many people in this world cannot bear sound doctrine. Instead, they persecute it.

I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and Christ Jesus, who is going to judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom: ²Preach the word. Be ready whether it is convenient or not. Correct, rebuke, and encourage, with all patience and teaching. ³For there will come a time when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, because they have itching ears, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in line with their own desires. ⁴They will also turn their ears away from the truth and will turn aside to myths. ⁵As for you, keep a clear head in every situation. Bear hardship. Do the work of an evangelist. Fulfill your ministry. ⁶You see, I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. ⁷I have fought the good fight; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith. ⁸From now on, there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness. The Lord, the righteous Judge, will give it to me on that day, and not only to me but also to everyone who loved his appearing.






