






First Lesson

Isaiah 45:1–7 (EHV)

The LORD shows his power over everything – even secular history – by prophesying how he would raise up Cyrus to rescue his people.

This is what the LORD says to his anointed one,

to Cyrus, whose right hand I have grasped,

to subdue nations before him

by stripping kings of their weapons,

to open doors before him

so that the gates cannot be shut.

²I myself will go before you,

and I will level high mountains.

I will break bronze doors into pieces,

and I will cut through iron bars.

³I will give you treasures hidden in darkness

and riches concealed in secret places,

so that you will acknowledge that I am the LORD,

the one who calls you by name, the God of Israel.

⁴For the sake of my servant Jacob,

for the sake of Israel my chosen one,

I will call you by your name.

I will give you an honored name, though you do not know me.

⁵I am the LORD, and there is no other.

Except for me, there is no god.

I will equip you even though you do not know me,

⁶so that people will know from the rising of the sun

to the place where it sets


that there is no one except me.

I am the LORD, and there is no other.

⁷I am the one who forms light and creates darkness,

the one who makes peace and creates disaster.

Second Lesson

Romans 13:1-7 (EHV)

St. Paul leaves no loopholes. Everyone is to submit to the governing authorities precisely because they have been established by God.

Everyone must submit to the governing authorities. For no authority exists except by God, and the authorities that do exist have been established by God. ²Therefore the one who rebels against the authority is opposing God's institution, and those who oppose will bring judgment on themselves.

³For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to evil. Would you like to have no fear of the one in authority? Do what is good, and you will receive praise from him, ⁴because he is God's servant for your benefit. But if you do wrong, be afraid, because he does not carry the sword without reason. He is God's servant, a punisher to bring wrath on the wrongdoer. ⁵Therefore it is necessary to submit, not only because of wrath, but also because of conscience.

⁶For this reason you also pay taxes, because the authorities are God's ministers, who are employed to do this very thing. ⁷Pay what you owe to all of them: taxes to whom taxes are owed, revenue to whom revenue is owed, respect to whom respect is owed, and honor to whom honor is owed.

Verse of the Day

Alleluia. Alleluia. In Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority. Alleluia. (Colossians 2:10)



Jesus teaches we are to give the government what belongs to the government. But we are not to give to the government what belongs only to God.

¹⁵Then the Pharisees went out and plotted together how to trap him in his words. ¹⁶They sent their disciples to him along with the Herodians. "Teacher," they said, "we know that you are truthful and teach the way of God in accord with the truth. You are not concerned about gaining anyone's approval because you are not swayed by appearances. ¹⁷So tell us, what do you think? Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar or not?"

¹⁸But Jesus knew their evil purpose and said, "Why are you testing me, hypocrites? ¹⁹Show me the coin used for the tax."

They brought him a denarius.

²⁰He asked them, "Whose image and inscription is this?"

²¹"Caesar's," they replied to him.

Then he said to them, "Therefore give to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's."




Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.
